## An introduction to Enduring Powers of Guardianship and Advance Health Directives

Enduring Powers of Guardianship (EPGs) and Advance Health Directives (AHDs) give adults with capacity, the power to direct how personal, lifestyle and treatment decisions would be made if they lost the capacity to make such decisions themselves.

Following the session, participants will have an understanding of:

- what an EPG and AHD are
- how an EPG and/or AHD can help people plan for their future
- what people should consider in deciding whether or not to make an AHD and/or EPG
- how to complete the forms
- the hierarchy of treatment decision-makers
- the role and responsibility of service providers regarding these new tools.
